Our Commitment

- Accessible Facilities Our centre has been designed with accessibility in mind to
 ensure all individuals can navigate and use our spaces with confidence. This includes
 lift access for every floor, a wheelchair-accessible bathroom, wide doorways and
 corridors to support mobility devices, and doors that can be fixed into an open
 position for ease of movement. Our coworking and event spaces are well lit, open,
 and kept clear of obstacles to minimise trip hazards and create a safe, supportive
 environment.
- Removing Barriers Where Possible We recognise that every person has different needs, and we are committed to working with individuals to remove barriers wherever possible. Whether through physical modifications, flexible arrangements, or providing additional supports, we aim to ensure that people with disability and high-needs requirements are able to engage equally in all aspects of our work—from coworking to programs, events, mentoring, and industry collaboration.
- Inclusive Participation We actively encourage participation from people with disability and those with additional support needs, and we value the unique perspectives they bring to our community. By creating spaces where everyone can contribute, we strengthen our collective ability to innovate and grow.
- Ongoing Improvement Accessibility and inclusion are not fixed achievements but areas of continual growth. We welcome feedback and are committed to reviewing and adapting our policies, facilities, and practices to improve over time. We also seek opportunities to partner with organisations, specialists, and community voices who can help us enhance accessibility within our centre and across the Mackay Isaac Whitsunday region.
